

- 21 Kannada speaking places were unified
- The Mysore State
- Renamed Karnataka on 1 November 1973

The Administration



- 191, 791 Sq km
- 6th largest state, 5.83% of India
- 8th largest by population
- 6th largest Economy
- 31 Districts
- 180 Taluks

BICAMERAL LEGISLATURE



- Council – 75 seats
- Assembly – 224 seats
- Rajya sabha – 12 seats
- Lok sabha – 28 seats

The Physical Features




- Highest elevation 1925

- largest number of Elephants in India



KARU NADU = STATE ON A PLATEUE



- Except coastal Karnataka, majority of the land on Deccan plateau
- 900 m above sea level

KARI NADU = THE LAND OF BLACK SOIL



- The northern part of Karnataka has black soil
- Suitable for cultivation of cotton

KAMMITTU NADU = THE LAND OF FRAGRANCE



- The Land of Sandal wood
- The Santalum album (White)
- The Pterocarpus santalinus (Red)

The Indus Valley Civilization




- Kannar Tribe

- 11% Silver mixed Gold


Rock Edicts of Ashoka ~ 350 BC




