Humility: Becoming role model and acquiring humility by serving food to juniors as well as to seniors.

Work Presentations

Work Presentations in Montessori helps the child to have a concrete understanding of the concept. The process is so structured that it supports the child to reproduce it in the written work. Work Presentation includes sandpaper alphabet tracing which helps the child to learn the sounds of the alphabet by means of muscular and visual memory, By tracing the letter repeatedly until it is registered.



Vowel Box

Vowel box helps the child to read the words and match to picture. Boxes are sorted so that the objects in each box isolate a specific vowel sound and objects to practice positive, natural learning experience to teach reading and writing.



Movable Alphabet

Movable alphabet helps to prepare the child for writing and reading from single word to phrases.



Exercises of Practical Life [EPL]

Practical Life activities help the child develop coordination, concentration, a sense of personal independence, and a sense of order.



Montessori Circle Time

It's a chance to sit together to share, either in a show-and-tell format or simply to have a conversation among themselves. Circle Time is the perfect time to sing rhymes together, to have conversation about new EVS topic, Play number games etc.



Hands-on: EVS

Create an environment and the child will learn through observation by stimulating intellectual absorption. Add repetition to it, we get 'master of the act'. Each learning is accompanied by Hands-on experience which satisfies the exploring spirit of a child.



Montessori : Sensorial Based Learning

Sensorial based learning is a way of learning which enables a child to engage their senses in order to aid in their learning and development.
